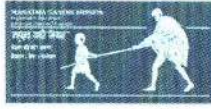



The acoustic enclosure/ acoustic treatment of the room should be designed for minimum 25 dB (A) insertion loss or for meeting the ambient noise standards, whichever is on higher side. - e. A proper routine and preventive maintenance procedure for DG set should be set and followed in consultation with the DG manufacturer which would help to prevent noise levels of DG set from deteriorating with use.
- f. D.G. Set shall be operated only in case of power failure.
- g. The applicant should not cause any nuisance in the surrounding area due to operation of D.G. Set.

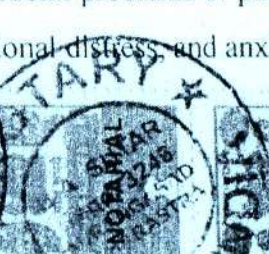
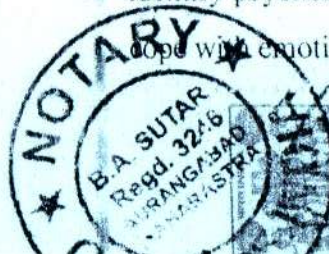

At the discretion of the attending provider, contact clinical supervisor or subject in charge to discuss any serious complications or change in status and collaborate recommended plan to support the psychiatric patients/families as appropriate.


Volume or Value of Referrals
Nothing in this MOU requires, is intended to require, or provides payment or benefit of any kind (direct or indirectly) for the referral of individuals or businesses to either Party by the other Party. Neither Party shall track referrals for purposes relating to setting the compensation of its professionals or influencing their choice.
Confidentiality
The Parties (and their directors, officers, employees, agents, and contractors) shall maintain the privacy and confidentiality of all information regarding the personal facts and circumstances of their psychiatric patients in accordance with all applicable state laws and regulations. The Parties (and their directors, officers, employees, agents, and contractors) shall not use or disclose psychiatric patients' information, other than as permitted or required by this MOU for the proper performance of duties and responsibilities here under. The Parties shall use appropriate safeguards to prevent use or disclosure of psychiatric patient's information, other than as provided for under this MOU.
Termination
This MOU may be terminated by either Party without penalty or cause by giving written notice (2 months before) to the other Party.
Notices
All notices and other communications required or permitted under this MOU, unless otherwise stated, shall be deemed duly given if in writing and delivered personally, via e-mail.
Dispute Resolution
If a dispute arises regarding this MOU, M.G.M. Mother Teresa College of Nursing, N-6, Aurangabad and Prerana Hospital, Aurangabad, shall first attempt to resolve it by informal discussions between the Parties, unless there are circumstances under which an extended resolution procedure may endanger the health and safety of psychiatric patients.



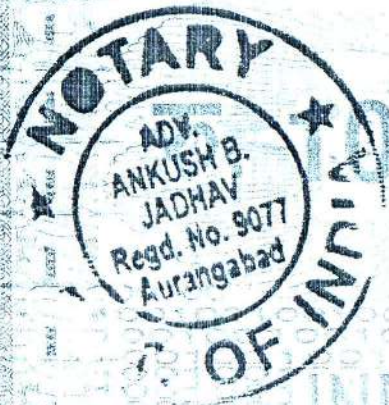
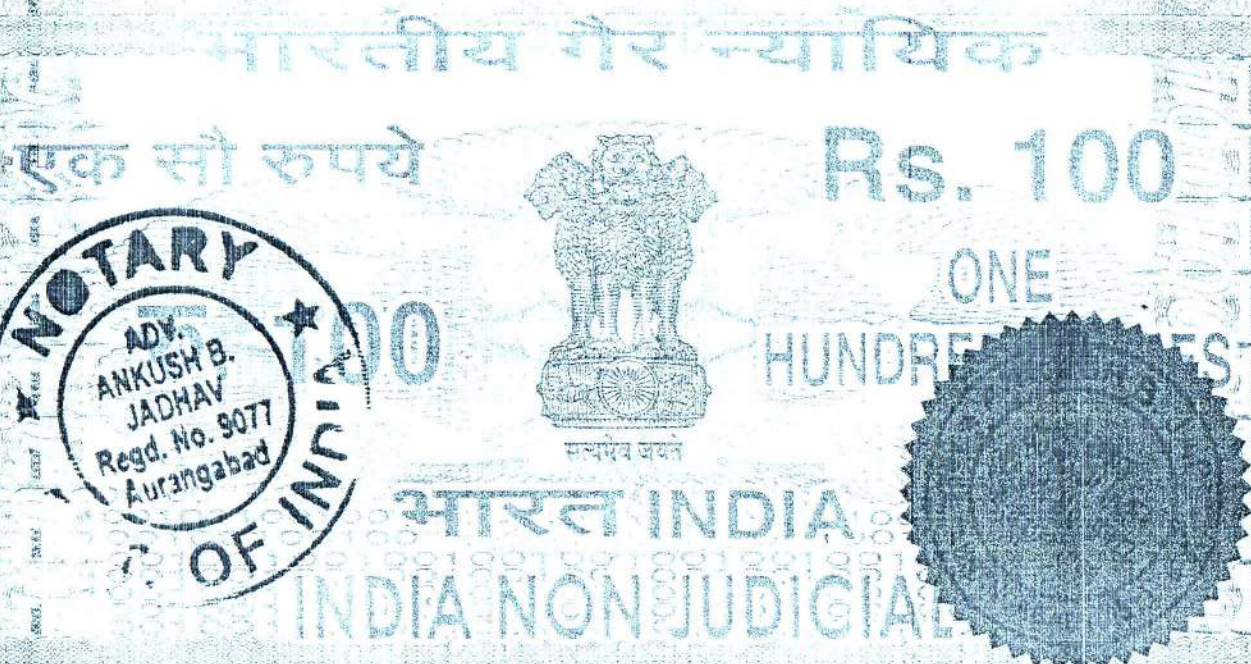
